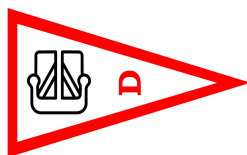


# Dufour Association

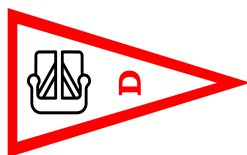
